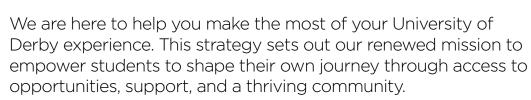

It sets out four key strategic priorities, Student Life, Student Communities, Student Voice and Student Employability, alongside the essential enablers and success measures that will guide our work over the coming years.

Central to delivering this strategy is our renewed focus on values and culture. The values we have developed, will shape how we work as a team, how we engage with our members and stakeholders, and how we bring this strategy to life. They will be embedded into our decision-making, service delivery, and relationships, ensuring that our culture supports the achievement of our goals and creates an inclusive, highimpact Union that students and union colleagues are proud to be part of.



Our Strategic Priorities

Our strategy is built around four connected priorities that support you through every stage of your student journey. They are not separate pillars, they work together to create a joined-up experience.

Here is how it flows

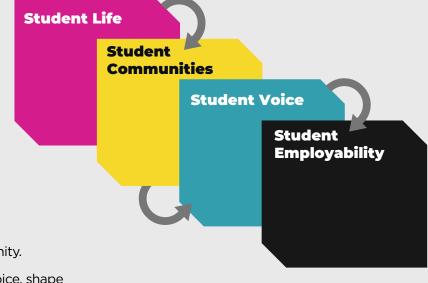
When your basic needs, like wellbeing, finances, and access to support are met, you're more likely to feel confident and connected.

- > Provide high-quality wellbeing and advice services to support students in key areas like finance, housing, and mental health.
- Develop engaging events and initiatives that bring students together, helping them to feel part of a welcoming and inclusive environment.
- > Enhance both physical and online spaces to ensure they are welcoming, engaging, and meet the needs of students.
- Strengthen partnerships with the university, local businesses, and community groups to ensure students have access to essential resources.

- Champion sustainability and social responsibility in all aspects of the Union's work, ensuring our activities create a positive and lasting impact.



Our aim is to empower and and support students to influence decisions and drive positive change through strong representation and advocacy.

What this means for students

- Students are supported to develop their skills in leadership, activism, and advocacy.
- Students see tangible outcomes from their engagement in representation structures and campaigns.

- Provide clear and accessible opportunities for students to voice their concerns and ideas.
- Strengthen representation structures to ensure student input is valued and acted upon.
- Improve feedback mechanisms to demonstrate the impact of student-led change.
- Empower underrepresented student voices, ensuring diverse perspectives shape decisionmaking at all levels.
- Improve data collection and feedback mechanisms to ensure transparency and responsiveness to student needs.



Our aim is to equip students with skills, experiences, and opportunities to support their career development and future success.

What this means for students

- Students are connected with professionals and opportunities that enhance their career prospects.

- Offer leadership development opportunities through student roles within the Union.
- Enhance the recognition of student leaders and volunteers, ensuring their contributions are acknowledged and valued.
- Develop employability-focused training and skill-building workshops.
- Strengthen partnerships with employers, alumni, and the university to connect students with career-enhancing opportunities.

What Will Help Us Make It Happen

Communication

Strengthening outreach and engagement through effective communication channels, ensuring students are informed, inspired, and actively involved with the Union

Data & Insight

Using data to make informed decisions that enhance student experiences, improve services, and ensure resources are used effectively. Using data driven insight to make strategic commercial and financial decisions, ensuring sustainability and reinvesting in services that benefit students

Finance

Ensuring financial sustainability through effective budgeting, diversifying our commercial offer and securing new income streams to support studentfocused activities

People & Culture

Investing in staff development, creating a positive and inclusive work environment, and ensuring the Union remains a great place to work. Ensuring good governance that supports the effective running of the Union as both a charity and a democratic organisation



How We Will Know It's Working

To make sure this strategy really delivers, we will keep track of progress using clear goals and regular feedback from students, our trustees, stakeholders, and staff.

Each year, we will develop an operational plan to bring this strategy to life. It will guide our progress toward achieving our vision and goals, while acting as a clear benchmark to measure improvements in service delivery year on year.

- Achieving a breakeven or surplus financial position, ensuring long-term sustainability
